

MAKING THE MOST OF THE LION, THE WITCH AND THE WARDROBE



- Hold a Narnia Party during the school holidays with Turkish Delight, Lion Cakes, Beaver Biscuits, Faun Fizz etc. Use the "Starting A Conversation" to get people talking.
- Offer to dress up as one of the characters from the book and offer to read a portion from one of the picture book adaptations of *The Lion, the Witch & the Wardrobe* at a local bookshop
- Organise a theatre party involving adults, children, or both and invite those who come to refreshments afterwards to informally discuss the film
- Invite several people whose Christian lives have been influenced by reading Lewis — or seeing the film — to speak at church
- Place a poster for the film with information about related church activities on a notice board that the community can see
- When school goes back, hold a SRE (Special Religious Education) assembly with a Narnia focus
- Book a local cinema for a special screening of the film and have a panel of Christians speak afterwards
- Ask a few people, including children, to write a review of the film for your church bulletin, para-church publication or local paper
- Screen a movie marathon of the BBC TV adaptation of four of the *Chronicles of Narnia*, with time for informal discussion in between
- Donate copies of Lewis' *Letters to Children*, audio copies of *The Chronicles of Narnia*, or a Christian book on the *Chronicles* to your library
- Have a Narnia Sunday where kids dress up as their favourite character. Have someone give a children's talk and sermon drawing on aspects of the film
- Order "Narnia: The Truth Inside the Fiction" booklets from Bible Society NSW and give them away as free gifts, for visitors to church, or at a fete or local market
- Encourage small groups, of adults or teens, to work through the "Narnia Bible Discussion Guide on The Lion, the Witch & the Wardrobe" (available from Bible Society NSW)
